The activities of athletic booster clubs are strictly regulated by the University Interscholastic League (UIL). A copy of the UIL Booster Club Guidelines is provided to each member and will be posted on the Blum ISD Website. Some additional guidelines are provided below:

1. The Blum Athletic Booster Club has space on the District website to post information for parents, students and the community.
2. An electronic copy of the following items should be sent to Elsa Scott to be posted on the District website:
 - A list of officers and members
 - A copy of the Booster Club By-laws
 - Treasurers' reports from each meeting
 - Minutes from each meeting
 - A schedule of meeting dates and times
 - Any notices about upcoming events or fund raising activities the group wants advertized
3. Officers should include but are not limited to the following: President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.
4. Minutes of each meeting should include:
 - The date, place and time of the meeting
 - List of those attending
 - A brief description of items for information or discussion
 - All motions, seconds and the vote counts
5. The Treasure's Report will include:
 - An itemized list of all revenue and expenses
 - Bank Balance
 - Donations made to Blum ISD Athletics
6. Donations made by the Athletic Booster Club to Blum ISD should be given to the secondary principal or his secretary to deposit in an account designated for that purpose.
7. Those funds will be used to support school athletic activities.
8. Coaches will direct their requests for meal money to Jeff Sanders.
9. Booster club members should direct inquires concerning the funds remaining in the school's account to Jeff Sanders or Barbra Tubbs.
10. All fund raisers should be coordinated through the superintendent's office.
